

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR DISPOSE OFF 108 OLD AMBULANCES THROUGH
e-Konugolu Portal**

1. To dispose 350 old ambulances (206 No. of vehicles parked at PHC, Peddaoutapally, A.P. and 144 vehicles parked at EMRI Campus, Medchal, Secunderabad, Telangana State) through AP e-Konugolu as per the G.O. Rt. No. 514, dt: 08.10.2018 of HMFV(1) dept.
2. All the vehicles will be sold as scrap on **“As is Where is”** condition
3. RCs and other papers will not be issued to the successful bidders
4. Before participating in the auction the bidders has to inspect all the vehicles on their own and no grievances will be entertained at the later case.
5. Base price to be fixed at Rs.40,000/-
6. Bid increment rate is fixed at Rs. 500/-
7. TCS will be collected @ 1% of (sale value + GST).
8. Bidders to pay the bid amount to e-Konugolu within 15 days from the date of bid confirmation
9. The successful bidders should lift the vehicles within 15 days from date of issue of delivery order by e-Konugolu. If he fails to lift the vehicle within 15 days, penalty of Rs. 500/- per day per each vehicle will be collected from the bidder. After 30 days the bidder has to forego bid amount paid and delivery order will be cancelled.
10. Auto extension time for auction is fixed at 5 minutes.
11. To pay an EMD of Rs. 5,000/- per each vehicle. The mode of payment shall be made as per guidelines under the caption of **“Payment Gateway guidelines”** at e-Konugolu website. The last date to deposit EMD shall closes, 24hours prior to the commencement of each day auction.
12. The committee chairman/ his authorized representative reserves the right to accept / reject , any offer / bid for the vehicles offered for sale in full or part thereof, prior to or after the acceptance of bid without specifying any reasons thereof.
13. Each vehicle is considered as one lot.
14. The CH&FW shall have the right to postpone / cancel to withdraw vehicles, stop the sale and re-auction the same and amend the terms and conditions without assigning any reasons / notice thereof.

15. The successful bidder should make his own arrangements to lift the lot /lots from the location.
16. GST will be collected at the rate of 18% on sale value or as applicable on the date of auction from the bidder. Each day 3 auctions will be conducted.
17. No guarantee is given in any sort, and no grievance will be entertained by the Dept. after auction.
18. Any dispute will be settled in Vijayawada jurisdiction only.
